That's why we want to share the story of one of our brave teenage clients who came to us at just 13, after enduring years of neglect and physical abuse. When she began therapy, she couldn't name a single strength in herself. She didn't yet know that just showing up—choosing to be there—was already an act of remarkable courage.

Through consistent commitment and the care of her therapy team, something incredible happened. Over time, she was able to uncover and embrace three beautiful traits within herself: *Joy. Friendship. Bravery*.

These aren't just words—they're proof of her resilience. They are the light she grew within herself, despite the darkness she had faced. And today, they stand as a testament to how far she has come.

We hope that every child who walks through our doors will discover—just like she did—that they are deeply valuable and infinitely worthy.





When a child completes their therapy journey, our therapists mark the moment with a special graduation party for the child and their family. Think cupcakes, drinks, and fun activities designed just for them.



Safe Sleep Classes

The CARES Center at the Emily Odum Institute is offering a free Safe Sleep Class designed to help parents and caregivers create a safe sleeping environment for infants. This class is an essential resource for anyone caring for a baby and is open to the community.

All classes are held at the CARES Center and require advance registration to attend. During the session, you'll learn about the latest safe sleep recommendations, how to reduce the risk of SIDS (Sudden Infant Death Syndrome), and tips for setting up a sleep space that supports your baby's health and safety.



Mandated Reporter Training

At the ECCAC, our Prevention Team stays active in the community even when they're not teaching the "Safety Matters" program in elementary schools across Okaloosa and Walton Counties. One of their key efforts includes providing Mandated Reporter Training—an essential program designed to educate professionals and community members on how to recognize and respond to signs of child abuse or neglect.

Mandated reporting is a legal and ethical responsibility for certain professionals—like teachers, counselors, law enforcement, and healthcare providers—to report any suspected child abuse or neglect. This training helps ensure that those on the frontlines know the warning signs, understand how to make a report, and feel confident taking the necessary steps to help keep children safe.


