Greetings!

October is a season of transition - summer fades, routines shift, and change is in the air. It's also a time that reminds us how powerful growth can be, even when it begins in difficult places. With that in mind, we want to share the story of one young woman whose journey through hardship and healing is a powerful reflection of resilience.

In 2022, we met a teenage girl who carried a heavy mix of emotions that often came out as anger. She felt the pressure to act like everything was fine, to love the very people who had let her down, and to figure out what to do with feelings she couldn't quite name.

At her first session, she made it clear she didn't believe therapy could help. "There's nothing I can get out of this. Anything you have to say or 'teach me,' I can just find online," she told us. Her body language spoke just as loudly - closed off and ready to walk away.

But she came back. Week after week, despite the challenges of homelessness, Baker Acts, moving to a new county, and the ups and downs of adolescence - she kept coming back.

Over time, she began to trust the process. She opened up at her own pace, and as she did, she started to heal. She not only worked through her trauma, but she also began connecting the dots between her past and how it affected different areas of her life. She learned to set boundaries and remove people who brought back those same painful emotions. She found her voice and used it, even when it scared her.

This young woman discovered a resilience she didn't know she had. She built healthy relationships, advocated for herself, and developed tools to face life's difficulties with courage and confidence.

Four years later, the transformation is undeniable. The girl who once declared therapy could not help

her has grown into a strong, remarkable young woman who uses the skills she learned every day. Ending therapy was hard for her - because she could see how much she had grown and didn't want to let go.

Her journey is a powerful reminder of what happens when healing meets resilience. She is proof that even when trauma tries to bury strength, it can be uncovered, nurtured, and reclaimed.

Every so often, a child's story touches us in a way that reminds us exactly why we do what we do. One of our therapists recently shared about a client whose journey reflects both the deep challenges many children face and the incredible resilience they carry within them.

At just 11 years old, this kiddo has already lived through more than most of us can imagine. His first 7 years were filled with hardship, followed by 12 different foster homes. In his recent session, he opened up about the weight of his past and his fear of facing more instability ahead.

And yet—he shines. He is resilient, courageous, and full of heart. In that same conversation, he shared a song with me that he said felt like it was written about his life: "Sunrise" by Forrest Frank. Even in the face of so much loss, he continues to find connection, hope, and meaning.

It's children like him who remind us why our work matters. Every child deserves the chance to feel safe, supported, and rooted in love.


Elliott commented on her new Board position, "I am inspired by the work of ECCAC because I believe every child deserves to feel safe, supported, and valued. As a young professional, I


